You will have an intensive exchange with local people and will get to know more about the life and the battle of Kurds. You won't only learn more about the kurdisch region and society, it is also intended to support the social awakening and to publicize your experiences here.

The exact sequence of the tour will be fixed in march.

We also want to point out that this trip won't be a tourist tour but is related to political responsibility.

In order to give response to the questions of the delegations participants there will be a preparation meeting for this trip, more details will be published soon.

Following the delegation there will be another meeting to evaluate the trip and sum up the documented experiences, discussions, impressions and celebrations in order to publish them back in Germany (FRG).

The journey will take place between 18. to 31st of march 2015. We will try to keep the costs as low as possible by asking supporters. Experiences show that there will be expenses of about 500€ (incl. Flight). In case of financial difficulties there can be a way to support several participants.
